School Communication

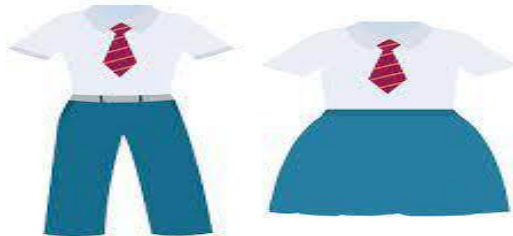


If you need to contact your child's teacher for any reason, please continue to do so through their individual school email or through the school office.

School Uniforms



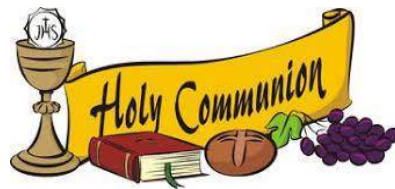
